FORECAST OF OLYMPIC FIRE AIRCRAFT ACTIVITIES FOR APRIL 1974

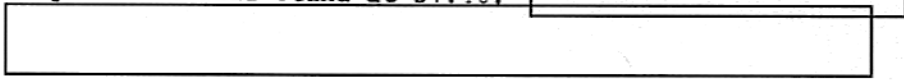
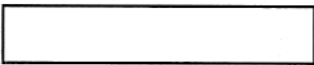

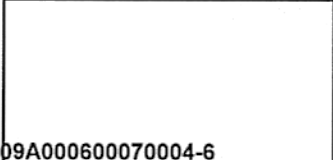

As of 19 March the USIB requirement for 90% of Cuba to be photographed quarterly showed 92.0% of the area covered. By 1 May 1974, if no missions are flown during the remainder of March or April, the quarterly requirement will stand at 51.4%. 	25X1
